

Description of Activity: Working tests and field trials are a meeting for the purpose of holding a competition to assess the work of gundogs Retrievers: There are either three or four judges who assess the dogs work. The dogs are required to walk steadily to heel, to be steady to shot and retrieve dead or wounded game/objects gently to hand from land or water.
